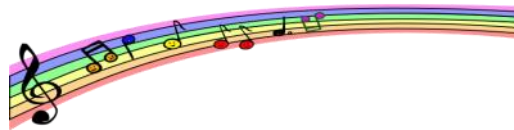


# **EASTER CONCERT—Thursday** **30th March—School Hall.**
