

SPORTS DAY

Lets all keep our fingers crossed for good weather on Friday 19th May, our Sports Day. If the weather is against us a decision will be made ASAP and put on the noticeboard in the front playground for you to check. We will post any cancellation decisions on the front page of the school website.

The plan for sports day is:

Morning Please could the children come to school wearing a P.E. kit in their house colours - Phoenix (Yellow), Griffin (Red), Dragon (Green) and Centaur (Blue), the children should be able to tell you the house they are in but Class 1 parents might like to double check with Mrs Haskins or Mrs Knowles! A coloured T shirt with their normal PE shorts will be fine. If you do not have a coloured top then please send them in in their normal PE top.

The children will be outdoors all day so a water bottle, sun cream and hat are essential.

For morning activities, we take the whole school to the field where the children complete in individual activities through which they are able to gain points for their houses.
