## MESSAGES FROM MR GOLDSWORTHY.....

I am receiving an increase in the number of comments made to me about parking and driving in the village at drop off and pick up times. The walk to school morning saw a large number of children and parents leaving their cars at the Pots' carpark and have an enjoyable walk down to school and this also had a positive impact on the parking situation in the village. Those involved in the walk said that there was an issue with cars driving too quickly past them, some of which were cars on the school run! Please remember that during these busy times of the day, it is particularly important to remember that 20 really is plenty!

We also have an issue with cars coming over the bridge in front of school often at speed in order to drop off or pick up children. Please do not do this, it is not safe.

It has also been noted that a few cars are repeatedly parking on the yellow zigzag line. These lines are there to reduce the risk of accidents between traffic and children and must not be parked on.

As part of our safeguarding responsibilities, the school must have control over the adults who enter the building. We also need to know who is in the building in the event of a fire. Please do not enter the school beyond the front office/reception area without permission being given to do.

In an assembly, the children have been given the yearly Sun-Safety message which we will continue to reinforce through the summer months. Please apply sun lotion of an appropriate factor on your child before school. If they need to top this up during the day then please ensure the bottle is clearly labelled with their name and make it clear to your child that they must not share it with other children. A sunhat is also recommended along with a wide brim. The children have also been reminded about the need to drink water regularly and this is available in class if they forget their bottle.

## **SPORTS DAY—Reminders**

Lets all keep our fingers crossed for good weather on Friday 26th May, our Sports Day. If the weather is against us a decision will be made ASAP and put on the noticeboard in the front playground for you to check. We will post any cancellation decisions on the front page of the school website.

### **The plan for sports day is:**

**Morning** Please could the children come to school wearing a P.E. kit in their house colours - Phoenix (Yellow), Griffin (Red), Dragon (Green) and Centaur (Blue), the children should be able to tell you the house they are in but Class 1 parents might like to double check with Mrs Haskins or Mrs Knowles! A coloured T shirt with their normal PE shorts will be fine. If you do not have a coloured top then please send them in in their normal PE top.

### **The children will be outdoors all day so a water bottle, sun cream and hat are essential.**

For morning activities, we take the whole school to the field where the children complete in individual activities through which they are able to gain points for their houses.

### **Lunch and Afternoon**

We will have a **picnic lunch at 12pm** on the Rec, parents are very welcome to join us and your child can come and sit with you for lunch. Children who would like a school packed lunch on this day will be able to choose from ham, tuna or cheese in the morning. **Races will start at approximately 1.00 p.m.** Please could parents sit on the opposite side of the track from the children ensuring there is space between them and the track! At the end, we gather at the pavilion steps and the trophy will be presented to the winning house. During the afternoon Friends will be selling, teas, coffees and cakes, please bring some money with you.

### **End of Day**

At the end of the day, children must gather with their class to be dismissed by their teacher so we can keep a register of who has gone. We will then walk the rest of the children back to school to be picked up at normal home time. Please inform the school office if you would like someone other than yourself to collect your child from the Rec.

### **Car parking**

Please be advised that all parents need to park in the car park and rugby area NOT on the rec as in previous years. Cherry Trees Pre-school have asked to remember that parents will be collecting their children when our parents are arriving for Sports Day. Please be considerate.

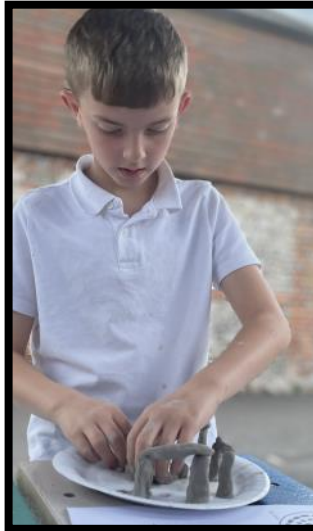




### Class 3—Stonehenge
