Curriculum Update

I am delighted to be able to share with you the news that our school's curriculum is now available for you to view on the school's website. We have spent the last year piecing together a curriculum which is exciting, interesting and relevant whilst also meeting the requirements of the national curriculum. Our Early Years class, Squirrels, have developed their curriculum to include a set of aspirations which the children We have uploaded to the website the yearly overviews for each class 1 & 2, 3 & 4 and 5 & 6 which show which unit of work will be covered each half term in each subject. We have also uploaded an overview of the units for each subject area onto the subject pages along with knowledge progressions which show the sequence of learning that will take place through the school.




To stock the Book Shop we are asking <u>EVERYONE</u> to please donate 3 reading books that can be sold on World Book Day

Pop your preloved books in the box outside the school's front door on the dates above.








Hi Everyone
