Curriculum Update

I am delighted to be able to share with you the news that our school's curriculum is now available for you to view on the school's website. We have spent the last year piecing together a curriculum which is exciting, interesting and relevant whilst also meeting the requirements of the national curriculum. 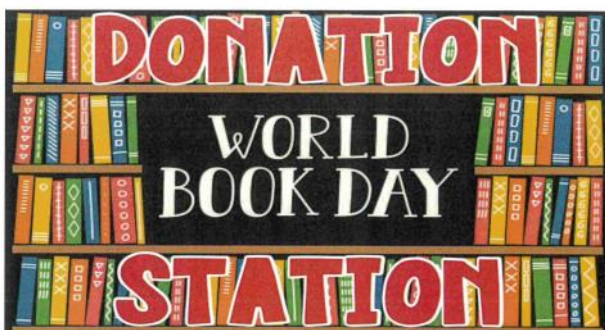

The day will be filled with exciting activities!!



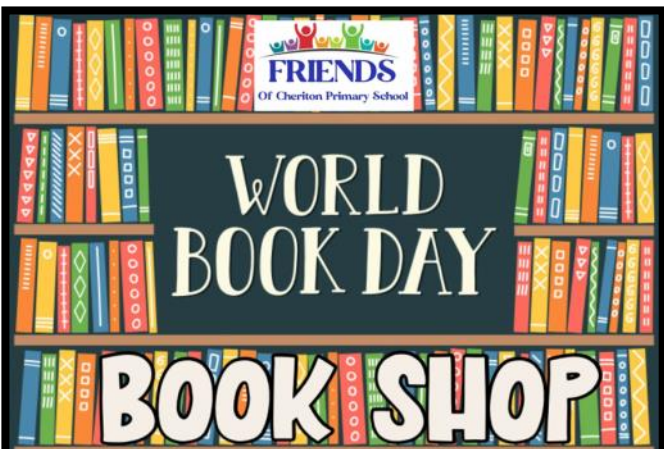

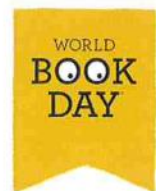
Hi Everyone
