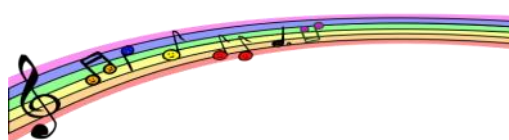


## SPRING CONCERT—Thursday 21st March—School Hall.

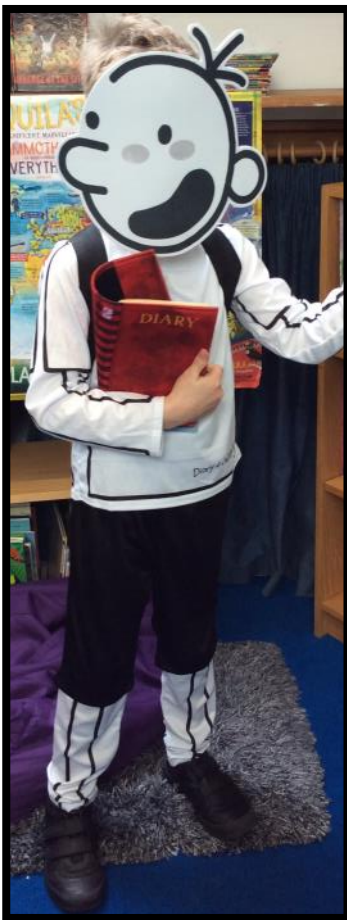
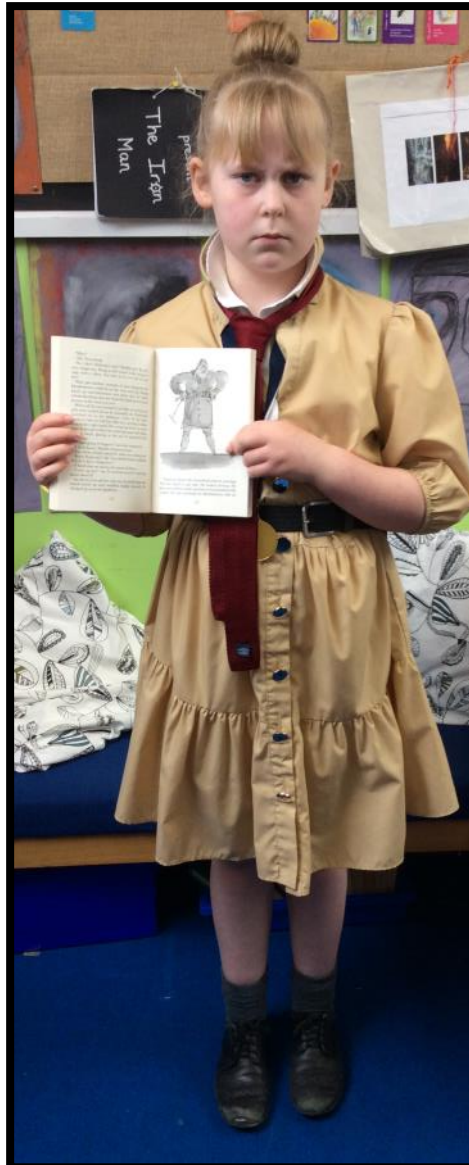

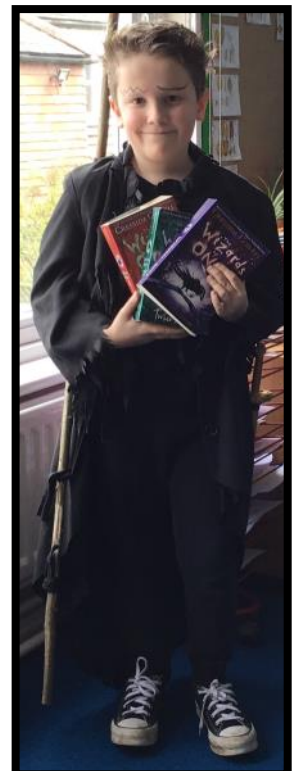
