Record breaking turnout for Film Night - Despicable Me 4 last week with 48 kids! Thank you to the parent volunteers that helped run the evening, the children had a great time!



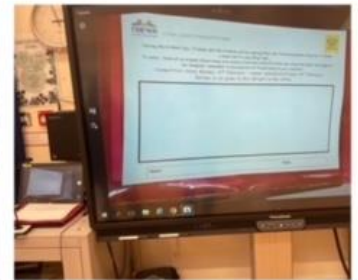

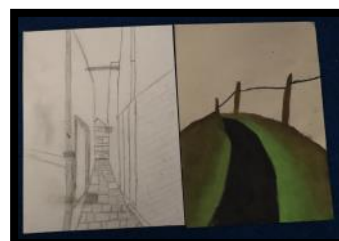
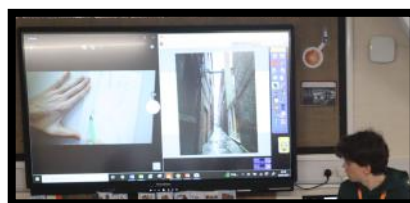
