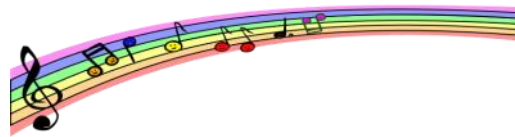

Her reason for growing her hair so long was to, as her sister had done previously, donate her beautiful hair to "The Little Princess Trust".

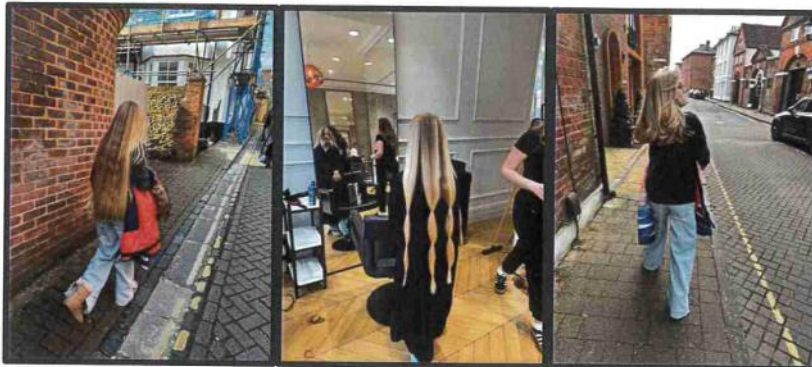
"The Little Princess Trust" was set up in 2005 in memory of Hannah Tarplee. When she was diagnosed with a Wilms Tumour in 2004 the loss of her hair was especially traumatic.

Her parents struggled to find a wig suitable for her during treatment, and felt the most fitting tribute to the five-year-old would be a charity dedicated to providing wigs for children who had lost their own hair due to cancer treatments and other conditions.

"The Little Princess Trust" was born and the charity has helped thousands of people, up to the age of 24, regain their confidence and identity by giving them a wig.

Lucy has donated her hair, now we need your help.....it costs £700 to provide a child with a wig, it's a lot of money, but for such a worthwhile cause, I know we can do it!
