# **FLU IMMUNISATION**

The nursing team are due to attend the school to carry out the Nasal Flu immunisation session on Thursday 18th September.

Parents/carers that have not submitted an electronic consent form please do so no later than 48 hours prior to this date. This will allow time for the nurses to triage the forms in preparation for the session.

If anyone needs support to completing the electronic consent, please just ask. Alternatively, you can contact the School Age Immunisation team, see below.

**Parents only need to complete 1 consent form per child.**
